


Weekly Report: Hong Kong Week ending 3 July 2022

(Data received up to 10 AM, THURSDAY 7 July)

SARS-CoV-2 activity remained low but influenza-likeness illness was increasing 392 participants this week

Influenza-like illness activity:

Fever and cough: 0.5% this week (Influenza and COVID-19 share some common symptoms*)



Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) or PCR test for SARS-CoV-2:

RAT positive: 0.5% this week (192 participants tested)

RAT or PCR positive: 0.5% this week (198 participants tested)




