

Influenza-like illness activity

Due to the control measures against the COVID-19 pandemic, influenza virus activity is historically lower than observed in the past decades.¹

We received 16,308 completed surveys from April 2021 to March 2022. The average influenza-like illness rate, as measured by self-reported fever and cough, was 0.5%, which started to increase since February 2022 and peaked in March during the fifth wave of COVID-19. Please note that fever and cough are common symptoms of COVID-19 and flu.










Among FluTracking participants who reported having fever and cough, 36.5% sought medical care², and none of them reported positive test result for flu.



Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 activity

The fifth wave of COVID-19 began in early 2022. By using the positive rate of COVID-19 tests, FluTracking keep track of the SARS-CoV-2 activity in the community. The positive rate peaked in early March.










Among FluTracking participants who reported having sore throat, 85.4% sought medical care², and 28.4% reported positive test result for COVID-19.
