


Weekly Report: Hong Kong Week ending 26 June 2022

(Data received up to 10 AM, THURSDAY 30 June)

SARS-CoV-2 activity remained low but influenza-likeness illness was increasing 395 participants this week

Influenza-like illness activity:

Fever and cough: 0.3% this week (Influenza and COVID-19 share some common symptoms*)



RAT or PCR positive: 0.0% this week (208 participants tested)




